Travel Information

You are responsible to have all your necessary valid travel documents with you.

You must ensure that your baggage has not been left unattended at anytime. If it has been left unattended or if you have been given articles to carry by another person, you must contact the check-in counter at the airport.

Bringing liquids on board

In compliance with international security regulations, any liquid items (including gels, pastes and similar) which are carried into the aircraft cabin must be packed in individual containers with a capacity of not more than 100ml (1 dl). These containers must themselves be carried in a re-sealable transparent plastic bag with a maximum capacity of one liter, to enable them to be separately screened at airport security checkpoints.
